Our oceanfront campground features 130 campsites and three cottages spread out over a mile of Casco Bay shoreline. We have been welcoming guests from all over the world for over 50 years, and many families return annually to have a truly "Maine experience". Campers enjoy the fresh air and ocean breezes while camping, hiking, touring the farm, taking a bike ride, or just spending a leisurely afternoon by the water with a favorite book.

What Do Groundskeeping Crew Members Do?

Wolfe's Neck is an amazing place to work! You arrive each day with views of gorgeous oceanfront pastures, happy cows grazing and people of all ages enjoying the outdoors. Groundskeepers work both in a small team and independently, performing ongoing landscaping tasks, helping to prepare for events, and maintaining the property's buildings, drinking water and waste management systems. The campus features many acres of campsites and recreational fields that require regular mowing (both riding and push), and weed-whacking. Tools, both power and manual, are used to ensure the property is running smoothly and looking its best. Crew members regularly assist campground guests, restock the camp store's firewood supply and work with event staff to move picnic tables before weddings.
